Syntax

selector:pseudo-class { property: value; }

Anchor Pseudo-classes ()

CSS Links /* unvisited link */ a:link { color: red; } /* visited link */ a:visited { color: green; } /* mouse over link */ a:hover { color: hotpink; } /* selected link */ a:active { color: blue; }

Note: a:hover come after a:link and a:visited in the CSS definition in order to be effective.

Note: a:active MUST come after a:hover in the CSS definition in order to be effective.

a:hover CSS a:link a:visited
a:active CSS a:hover
