## The alt Attribute

The alt attribute is used to describe the image. It is placed inside the `<img>` tag, after the `src` attribute, and is enclosed in quotation marks.

If a browser cannot find the image, it will display the alternate text:



### Tip:

For accessibility, use a descriptive alt text (screen reader) in HTML. This helps users who are blind or have low vision understand the content of the image.

## Image Size - Width and Height

The `width` and `height` attributes are used to specify the size of the image. They can be specified in pixels or as a percentage of the page width.

```
<img src = "img_girl.jpg" alt="Girl in a jacket" style="width:500px; height:600px;">
```

The `width` and `height` attributes can also be used to specify the size of the image in pixels.

### Note:

When using the `width` and `height` attributes, the values must be in quotes. For example, `width="500"` and `height="600"`.

## Width and Height, or Style?

The `width`, `height`, and `style` attributes are used to specify the size of the image. The `style` attribute is used to specify the size of the image in pixels.

```
/* This style sets the width of all images to 100%: */ img { width: 100%; }
```

## Width/Height Attribute or Style?

The first image uses the width attribute (set to 128 pixels), but the style in the head section overrides it, and sets the width to 100%;



The second image uses the style attribute to set the width to 128 pixels, this will not be overridden by the style in the head section:
