- description : JavaScript getDay() Method

## Definition and Usage

`getDay()` returns the day of the week for the date specified in the parameter. (0 = Sunday, 1 = Monday, ..., 6 = Saturday).

### Note:

0, 1, ..., 6

## Syntax

```
Date.getDay()
```

## Return value

0, 1, ..., 6

  function myFunction() {
    var d = new Date();
    var weekday = new Array(7);
    weekday[0] = "Sunday";
    weekday[1] = "Monday";
    weekday[2] = "Tuesday";
    weekday[3] = "Wednesday";
    weekday[4] = "Thursday";
    weekday[5] = "Friday";
    weekday[6] = "Saturday";

    var n = weekday[d.getDay()];
    document.getElementById("demo").innerHTML = n;
  }
</script>
