

JavaScript getDay() Method

- description : JavaScript getDay() Method
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```
function myFunction() {  
    var d = new Date();  
    var n = d.getDay();  
    document.getElementById("demo").innerHTML = n;  
}
```

Definition and Usage

getDay() returns the day of the week for the specified date. The method returns a value between 0 and 6, representing the days of the week from Sunday to Saturday.

Note:

0 represents Sunday, 1 represents Monday, 2 represents Tuesday, 3 represents Wednesday, 4 represents Thursday, 5 represents Friday, and 6 represents Saturday.

Syntax

```
Date.getDay()
```

Return value

0 to 6, representing the days of the week from Sunday to Saturday.

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```
function myFunction() {  
    var d = new Date();
```

```
var weekday = new Array(7);
weekday[0] = "Sunday";
weekday[1] = "Monday";
weekday[2] = "Tuesday";
weekday[3] = "Wednesday";
weekday[4] = "Thursday";
weekday[5] = "Friday";
weekday[6] = "Saturday";

var n = weekday[d.getDay()];
document.getElementById("demo").innerHTML = n;
}
```
